CW6	<p>“(i) the lack of suitable non-Green Belt sites”, should be deleted and replaced with:</p> <p>“(i) A clear demonstration that no other suitable sites are available within the urban area”</p>
WD2	<p>In the preamble to the list of sites under iii), it should require that any proposal to provide a waste treatment facility should include an appraisal of that site compared to other listed sites, to demonstrate which site is the best practical option, with least environmental impact</p>
WD2	<p>In the list of identified sites, Land adjacent to Trumps Farm, Longcross, should be deleted as it fails the test in Policy CW5 (vi) in that it is not well served by the strategic road network, nor accessible by alternative means of transport</p>
WD2	<p>In the list of identified sites, Land adjacent to Trumps Farm, Longcross, should be deleted as it fails the test in Policy DC2 in that it has not been demonstrated in accordance with the Habitats Directive 1994, that there would be no adverse impact on the integrity of Natura 2000 sites</p>
WD5	<p>In the preamble to the list of sites under iv), it should confirm that any proposal to provide a waste treatment facility should include an appraisal of that site compared to other listed sites, to demonstrate which site is the best practical option, with least environmental impact</p>
WD5	<p>In the list of identified sites, Land adjacent to Trumps Farm, Longcross, should be deleted as it fails the test in Policy CW5 (vi) in that it is not well served by the strategic road network, nor accessible by alternative means of transport</p>
WD5	<p>In the list of identified sites, Land adjacent to Trumps Farm, Longcross, should be deleted as it fails the test in Policy DC2 in that it has not been demonstrated in accordance with the Habitats Directive 1994, that there would be no adverse impact on the integrity of Natura 2000 sites</p>
