

NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

1. GENERAL:

Under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisement) Regulations many outdoor advertisements require consent before they can lawfully be displayed. It is an offence to display an advertisement without consent. Guidance on whether consent is required can be given by Council Officers.

2. AREAS OF SPECIAL CONTROL:

Most of the rural area of Runnymede is covered by such a restriction, which prohibits display of certain advertisements, and imposes limitations on others. Council staff can give further advice.

3. PERIOD OF CONSENT:

Consent may only be granted for a period of five years, although an application is not required to renew it after that period. If a shorter period of consent is required, this should be clearly indicated in the advertisement description in Question 3.

4. OWNER'S CONSENT:

It is a condition of any consent granted that before that advertisement is displayed, the permission of the owner of the land, or other person entitled to grant permission, is obtained.

5. OTHER CONSENTS:

Express consent for the display of an advertisement does not relieve the applicant from obtaining any other relevant permission, i.e. Listed Building Consent, Building Regulations approval, etc.

6. SITE PLANS:

Each application should include a site plan of not less than 1/2500 scale, showing the site to which it refers edged red. Any other land or buildings owned by the applicant should be edged blue.

7. OTHER DRAWINGS:

The application should include detailed scale drawings (in metric measurement) which clearly show each advertisement, including its size, wording/symbols, etc., the height of such wording, the height of the highest part of the advertisement above ground level, colours (foreground and background), materials, whether illuminated or not, and means of illumination, and if possible the level of illumination, together with its exact location within the site. Where advertisements are proposed on buildings, scale drawings should be submitted showing the full elevation of the building as existing, and as proposed.
